Injury Care for Boarders Playing Club Sport

Hale School Registered Nurses are available 24 hours per day to review any boarder who sustains an injury. We are contactable via telephone: (08) 9347 0112 and welcome the opportunity to discuss with any coach or first aider any injury concerns.

In the instance of a player who sustains a **HEAD KNOCK**, nursing staff **MUST** be contacted so we can arrange review once the student returns to campus. First Aiders on ground who **Recognise** an injury and **Remove** the player, must ensure that boarding students are left in the company of an adult who can arrange close monitoring once that student returns to campus.

In the event of an Ambulance being called for one of our boarders, please contact the Duty Desk, advise which hospital the student is going to and request a staff member meet the Student (unless accompanied by an Adult) in the emergency department.

Hale Health Centre runs an injury clinic every Sunday 5-7 pm and we encourage any student who is injured during club sport to attend so appropriate follow up care can be provided.

Injuries which occur during club competition can interfere with student's academic and sporting commitments at Hale and prompt review will minimise this interruption.
